




ENROLLMENT

45 SAIL programs enrolled 2449 students in 2018

- Average Attendance 88%
- Average Attrition 9%

SAIL cumulative enrollment has now surpassed 10,000



SAIL REACHES UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES

In the typical SAIL program:

- 99% of the students are eligible for free or reduced cost lunches
- The entering students are performing well below academic norms.
 The average beginning percentile is 25% in reading and 30% in math.

ACADEMIC GROWTH

SAIL programs incorporate research-based curriculum, certified teachers, and the STAR assessment to drive academic growth.

Average Instruction Hours:

Reading: 40 Math: 33

Average Gain per Student:

Reading: 2 months Math: 2.7 months

<u>Average Impact per Student</u> (considering the "summer slide" of 2+ months <u>loss</u> in low-income students):

Reading: 4+ months Math: 4.7+ months

SAIL IS COST EFFECTIVE

The average cost for an academic program is \$675 per graduate.
